

POOL RULES

COMMUNITY POOL GUIDELINES – SWIM SMART. SWIM SAFE

POOL HOURS: 8 AM – 8 PM

(Unless otherwise posted)



ACCESS & GUEST POLICY

- Pool use is for residents in good standing.
- One key/fob/wristband per household. Lost items may require a replacement fee.
- Show your pool access item if asked by HOA or staff.
- Don't let others in – no piggybacking or gate propping.
- Max 4 guests per household. Residents must accompany guests at all times.
- Hosting more than 4 guests? Get approval at least 3 business days in advance
- Residents are responsible for their children and/or guests



SAFETY & BEHAVIOR

- No lifeguard on duty – swim at your own risk.
- Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult (18+).
- All swimmers must wear proper swimwear.
- Children not toilet trained must wear swim diapers.
- No diving, running, horseplay, or loud/disruptive behavior.
- No profanity or inappropriate conduct.
- No tampering with pool equipment or gate mechanisms.



HEALTH & CLEANLINESS

- Shower before entering the pool.
- No one with open wounds or contagious illness may enter the pool.
- Diaper changing must be done in restrooms – not poolside.
- Trash must go in proper bins – help keep our pool clean.



NOT ALLOWED

- No alcohol
- No glass containers
- No food or drinks within 4 feet of the pool
- No smoking, vaping, hookah or chewing gum
- No pets in or around the pool
- No bikes, scooters, skates, or skateboards
- No hard/metal toys or oversized floats during busy hours
- No loud music – keep sound at a respectful volume



RESPECT & RESPONSIBILITY

- Use trash bins – keep the pool area clean.
- Respect staff, volunteers, and neighbors.
- Violations may lead to warnings or suspension of pool privileges.
- All residents are expected to behave respectfully.
- Violations may result in a warning, removal from the pool, or suspension of privileges.
- All homeowners have the authority and obligation to enforce rules

Let's keep the pool safe and fun for everyone. If you see something, say something! Report issues within 24 hours to the HOA board.
